Slip Fee Increase



On September 3rd, 2024 the City Commission approved a 10% rate increase for marina slip usage fees. The fee increase will take

effect beginning on October 1, 2024. The new rate will be included in the statement mailed to customers on approximately September 22nd.

For those enrolled in online bill pay through your bank account, please remember to update your payment amount in order to avoid incurring potential late fees.

Shore Power Safety Tips

Please be mindful of the following safety tips regarding shore power:

- Do not allow the cord to be in the water. Use a cord holder and store any excess cord length on the vessel, not on the dock.
- Never wrap cords around a shore power pedestal.
- Use only marine grade extension cords.
 Household extension cords are not permitted.



- Inspect entire cord, connectors and receptacles frequently for damage or charred areas.
- No altered cords are permitted.
- The 110 volt outlets on the pedestals are provided for accessories and are not intended for shore power connection to vessels.
- Shore power adapters should be used to connect marine grade extension cords being used to provide shore power to vessel systems.
