- ➤ **Apply and Wait:** Submit an application to determine your approval status and scholarship amount without enrolling/completing registration paperwork.
 - *If you decide to apply and wait, we cannot guarantee openings or reserve spots for you.

Paying Balances:

- o If enrolling prior to the start of camp, all families will need to pay the balance due for the first two weeks of camp by **May 23rd**. You will then adhere to the general payment schedule for deferred payments (see parent handbook).
- Parents/Legal Guardians applying after camp has started will need to put a \$25 deposit on ALL desired camp weeks if they want their child to begin attending immediately.
